1. This application has been filed under Order 23 Rule 3 CPC for withdrawal of the appeal in terms of the compromise dated 02.09.2024.
2. The learned counsel representing the parties have produced a deed of settlement, dated 02.09.2024 (Annexure A-1) which is stated to have been signed not only by the all the parties but also by two witnesses.
3. As per the deed of settlement, 50% of the total amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Ten lacs) has already been paid to the respondent-Mr. Prem Parkash, whereas a Demand Draft of the remaining amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Five lacs) has been handed over to Mr. Prem Parkash, who is present in

Court and identified by Sh. N.C.Kinra, Advocate. A photocopy of the demand draft No.000786, dated 27.09.2024, is placed on record.

4. For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is supported by an affidavit, the application is allowed and the Regular Second Appeal is disposed of in terms of the deed of settlement dated 02.09.2024 (Annexure A-1). The deed of settlement shall form part of the decree.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
