CR-1408-2024

1. Challenge in this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is to order dated 10.10.2023 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana, whereby an application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, which was filed during the pendency of the petition under Section 9 of the Act (supra), was disposed of.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the parties have effected a settlement, which has been reduced into writing as Compromise Deed dated 31.08.2024,



a copy of which has been produced in Court. It is further submitted that clause 6 of the terms and conditions therein, reads as thus:-

“6) That in the petition u/s 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act an application u/s 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act was filed by the party no.1 and the same was allowed vide order dated 10.10.2023 in which learned court had granted an amount of Rs.5,000/- per month as maintenance to the party no.1 and the party no.1 has filed an execution for recovery of arrears w.e.f. 1.2.2024 to 31.07.2024 which is pending in the court of Ms. Neelam Arora, Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana and is fixed for 3.9.2024. The party no.1 undertake to withdraw said execution as fully satisfied and moreover, she undertakes not to file any further execution pertaining to the said order dated 10.10.2023 as the party no.1 has received the amount of Rs.6,00,000/- towards all her claims including permanent alimony, past, present and future.”

- 3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition.
- 4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
