The petitioners, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No. 21 dated 30.01.2024, under Sections 326 / 324 / 323 / 427 / 452 / 336 / 148 / 149 of IPC and Sections 25 / 27 / 54 /59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

[2] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of order dated 04.03.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

[3] On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the prayer made in the petition.

[4] In this view of the matter, interim order dated 04.03.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
