1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been invoked seeking quashing of FIR No. 19, dated 29.01.2021 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar (Rural), with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-2).
2. Vide order dated 04.03.2024, parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court within a period of two weeks from that date for recording of their statements with regard to the genuineness of compromise and report to that effect was called for.
3. A report dated 10.04.2024 has been received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala stating that in compliance of order dated 04.03.2024, none of parties appeared in the Court for recording of their statements regarding compromise.

4. Today, neither the counsel for the petitioners nor the counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 has put in appearance, which is sufficient for this Court to infer that parties are not interested to pursue the present petition.

5. In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
