The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the private respondents and their family members from harassing or interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner was married to Gagandeep Singh with three children and husband of the petitioner died long back ago and since then, she is residing in her matrimonial house. He further submits that there was some dispute regarding property between the petitioner and her family members due to which private respondents entered in her house forcefully and given beatings to her. It is further submitted that the petitioner has registered a complaint against the private respondents but no action or FIR has been registered against them so far.

Later on, she has also filed a representation dated 27.02.2024 to respondent

No.2 but till date, no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
