1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C . for issuing direction to the official respondents No. 2 to 5 to decide the representation dated 25.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner against the private respondents No. 6 to 9 within a stipulated time period.

2. A status report, dated 16.04.2024 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Ashok Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, N.R.I. Wing, District S.A.S. Nagar, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Tejinder Singh, has informed that an FIR No. 0037, dated 09.04.2024, under Section 498-A of the IPC, has already been registered at Police Station NRI Wing, District SAS Nagar, against respondent No. 6 (the husband of the petitioner). A copy of the said FIR has also been supplied by learned State counsel in Court today. The same is also taken on record.

4. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that in view of the above, the representation 25.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner has now been disposed of.
5. Keeping in view the observations noticed hereinabove, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
6. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
