1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned orders dated 02.07.1998 (Annexure P-4), 05.08.1999 (Annexure P-5) and 28.11.2000 (Annexure P-6) and the award dated 09.03.1998 (Annexure P-3) be upheld.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner have sought adjournments to get instructions as to whether anything survives in the present petition or not on 29.02.2024 and 03.04.2024. He submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.
