Main case

Present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking setting
aside of order dated 25.1.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Court of
Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest
of the petitioners are issued by the trial Court on account of absence of the
petitioner before the said Court in criminal case having FIR No.58 dated
14.6.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 308, 148, 149 IPC and
Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was
granted regular bail by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala vide
order dated 17.7.2020 (Annexure P-7) and thereafter, the petitioner was
regularly appearing before the trial Court; that due to some unavoidable

circumstances, the petitioner jumped bail and consequently, order (Annexure P-3) has been passed by the trial Court. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings with the trial Court and further, he will remain careful in future.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. J.S.Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh submits that the petitioner jumped bail and consequently, impugned order (Annexure P-3) was passed by the learned trial Court as per provisions of law and there is no illegality or perversity in the same. State counsel further apprised that now the trial Court has started proceedings under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. against the petitioner.
5. In view of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in order to avoid further delay in trial, the petitioner is hereby directed to appear before the trial Court on or before the next date fixed in the trial and on his doing so, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction subject to furnishing of heavy surety and further subject to costs of ₹ 7,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority concerned.
