VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. On 20.05.2024, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that in spite of best efforts, he is not able to get in touch with the LRs of the appellant.

Let fresh notice be issued to LRs of the appellant for 06.09.2024.”

2. As per the report of the registry, one of the LRs of the appellant has died.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that inspite of the best efforts, he has not been able to get in touch with the legal representatives of the appellant and no one has contacted his office and thus, he is not in a position to state as to whether any cause survives in the present appeal as on date and hence, he prays that the present appeal may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty may be granted to the LRs of the appellant to revive the appeal, in case any cause of action survives.
