The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr. PC with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.136, dated 30.12.2023, under Sections 3,6,8,9,14 (2), 15,18 of Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act and under sections 420,120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
