Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 16.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.2 whereby he has arbitrarily suspended all the petitioners who are the panches of Gram Panchayat Bhungarka. Further prayer has been made to not to proceed with the order passed by respondent No.2 which is totally arbitrary, without application of mind and contrary to the provisions of law as well as the provision of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994. Further prayer has been made to direct the respondents not to take any action or to proceed further with, in the light of order passed by respondent No.2 which is under challenge in the present petition along with subsequent proceedings arising out of the impugned order may kindly be stayed.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternative remedy as available to them under law.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In case any such appeal is filed, the same would be decided expeditiously by the Appellate Authority in accordance with law, preferably within three months of its filing.
