1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the salary of the petitioner from April 1995 till date.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to the year 1998 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. As per the report of the registry, counsel for the petitioner has been informed but none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
