By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.172 dated 07.11.2023 registered under Sections 294, 341, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

As per allegations, complainant - Kulwant Singh along with his sister Veerpal Kaur and her husband Jagtar Singh were on way to their home, when they were waylaid by petitioner – Gurtej Singh along with co-accused Naib Singh and Gurbaj Singh. All three of them were armed with weapons. Gurbaj Singh was holding sword. Naib Singh was holding gandhali whereas Gurtej Singh – petitioner was holding baseball bat. All three of them caused injuries to the complainant- Kulwant Singh besides Veeerpal Kaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; that no specific injury attracting Section 326 IPC is attributed to him and that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the role attributed to the petitioner, who along with co-accused caused injuries to the

complainant and his sister, which attracted even Section 326 IPC, this Court is not inclined to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
