VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue admit card to the petitioner in the forthcoming examination w.e.f. 02.03.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a roll number is issued to the petitioner in the capacity of private candidate.

3. Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.1 has submitted that for the said purpose, the petitioner would have to go physically to the office of the Chairman, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani and after completing the necessary formalities including the deposit of late fee, every endeavour would be made to issue the roll number to the petitioner as

a private candidate within a period of two hours from the time the petitioner reaches the office of the Chairman, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

- i) The petitioner would go in person to the office of the Chairman, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani, with request to issue the roll number to him to appear as a private candidate in the 10th Class examination to be held by the Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani, which as per the case of the petitioner is starting on 02.03.2024.
- ii) The petitioner would also deposit the late fee, in accordance with the rules.
- iii) The Chairman, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani and its office is directed to make every endeavour to issue roll number to the petitioner within a period of two hours from the time the petitioner complies with the formalities as required under the rules / regulations.
