Reply by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar Sharma, Deputy Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the counsel for the petitioners.

In the present petition, the grievance raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners are not given the benefit of revised pay which they are entitled for and that too without any valid justification.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sanjay Kumar, Legal Assistant, submits that keeping in view the affidavit which has been filed today, Pay Order dated 20.02.2024 has been attached, according to which a sum of Rs.10,33,147/- has been paid to the petitioners and therefore, all the payment required to be done have already been given to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that no detail has been given as to how the amount has been calculated hence, the petitioners intends to approach respondents by appropriate speaking representation as to how the amount has been calculated and in case, after the details are furnished it is found, that the petitioners have not been given their dues, liberty be given to raise the dispute by filing an appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the same in the time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the representation is received from the petitioners, the same will be disposed of within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of any such request/claim.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly
