1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 14.05.2019 (Annexure P-1) vide which the application moved by the respondent-wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act has been partly allowed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the main divorce petition itself has been decided vide order dated 17.08.2022 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the petition, in case any cause of action survives.
