2. A perusal of the case file reveals that the present writ petition is lying pending since 2000. The petitioners by way of the present writ petition have prayed for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the shares to them and offset the loss suffered by them on account of the inaction/omission or commission on the part of the respondents, in not selling the shares/debentures seized from the premises of the petitioners on 24/25.07.1992, at the appropriate time, when asked for by the petitioners, from the Income Tax liability that may finally be found against them and to be restrained from charging any interest on account of delayed payment/adjustment as tax, since the liability to pay interest has come about due to the non-action of the department.



- 3. We find that since 1992, for several years, income tax returns must have been filed. The issue raised in the present petition on account of filing of the subsequent returns cannot be examined as the same has become in stay mode.
- 4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
- 5. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
