1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful disobedience of the order dated 04.10.2008 passed by this Court in CWP 4886-2003 titled as '*Court on its motion vs. State of Punjab and another*'.
2. Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which the contempt is asserted is of the nature, for determination of contempt for which a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of the disputed questions of fact would not even be appropriate in the contempt proceedings. Hence, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
