1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for wilful disobedience of order dated 04.10.2008, passed by this Court in CWP 4886-2003 titled as '*Court on its motion vs. State of Punjab and another*'.
2. The facts and circumstances involved in the case are of such nature that for assessing the non-compliance of the order, if any, would require determination of a lot of disputed question of facts. However, adjudicating upon the disputed question of facts would not be appropriate in the contempt petition. Hence, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.
3. Ordered accordingly.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternative remedy, but in accordance with law.
