1. Aforesaid case was filed by Ms. Swati Verma, Advocate on 17.03.2022 and Registry raised objections on 21.03.2022, which were not removed by learned counsel.
2. As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by counsel/party concerned who filed it, to be re-filed within a period of 40 days. The file in hand was never taken back for re-filing after removal of objections despite note published by Registry time and again.
3. Even today, nobody has turned up on behalf of petitioner(s).
4. Considering the aforesaid factual position, it appears that learned counsel who had filed present case is not interested to pursue the same. Therefore, it stands disposed off for want of prosecution.
