1. This appeal is pending for the last 33 years.
2. On 25.11.2024, the following order was passed:-

“It is evident that the appellants have failed to bring on record the legal representatives of the deceased-respondent nos.1, 3, 4 and 6, despite direction on 30.07.2024. This appeal is pending for the last 33 years. Once again a prayer for an adjournment has been made.

As a matter of last indulgence, two weeks' time is granted to the appellants to file an application for bringing on record legal representatives of the deceased-respondent nos.1, 3, 4 and 6, failing which the appeal will be deemed to have been dismissed without further reference to the court.

3. As per the office report, no miscellaneous application has been filed to bring on record the legal representatives of respondent no.1, 3, 4 and 6.

4. The learned counsel representing the appellants submits that despite his best efforts, he failed to contact the appellants.
