SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, vide which the petitioner is asking for direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation in FIR No. 0036, dated 05.04.2016, registered under Sections 365, 427 IPC as well as FIR No.144 dated 04.11.2017, registered under Sections 448, 427, 354, 506, 149 IPC, at Police Station Dhariwal to some other district except Districts Pathankot or Amritsar for free and fair investigation as the investigation of both the aforesaid FIRs is being influenced by the local MLA of the constituency to implicate the petitioners No.1 and 2 and their family members in false FIRs, in the interest of justice.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in this case trial has been concluded and the accused have been acquitted vide judgment dated 26.04.2019.

- 3. In view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
- 4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
- 5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
