Prayer in the present petition is for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to release the 9th and 10th instalments amounting to Rs.7,00,000/- each of interest free loan to the petitioner-firm and for rescheduling the repayment of loan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has no further instructions in the matter as the case was last listed for hearing in the year 2016.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand, has drawn the attention of this Court to memo No.9317, dated 23.08.2001, whereby no due certificate had been issued to the petitioner after recovery of the entire principal amount in the Government treasury. He further contends that since no due certificate has already been issued, there is apparently no dispute, which survives.
