JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of award dated 22.08.2000 (Annexure P-5) whereby Labour Court has answered the reference in favour of the workman granting reinstatement along with full back wages.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 15.01.2024 has disposed of CWP-2674-2001 and CWP-2676-2001 and case of petitioner is squarely covered by said order. This Court has awarded lump sum compensation of Rs. 2.5 lacs to each workman-respondent in the above mentioned petitions.

3. The petitioner-State, at the same moment, had filed this petition. Two petitions were disposed of by aforesaid order, however, case of present workman-respondent was not taken up.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the respondents expressed his inability to controvert the fact that case of petitioner is squarely covered by aforesaid order.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to petitioner to pay a sum of Rs. 2.5 lacs to workman-respondent within 3 months from today.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
