1. This appeal has come up for hearing after a period of 30 years.
2. A suit for grant of decree of permanent injunction was filed by the respondents, which was dismissed by the trial Court, however, decreed by the First Appellate Court. The learned counsel representing the appellant submits that despite his best efforts, he failed to contact the appellant.
3. During the period of 30 years, the appeal may have lost its efficacy. Hence, the appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the appellant to file an application for revival, if required.
4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
