MAIN CASE

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, *inter alia*, for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to investigate/enquire into the matter through some higher Officers of the police or some independent Agency as petitioners are being harassed and humiliated repeatedly by way of lodging false FIRs by the police authorities.

(2) Learned State Counsel has produced the copy of order dated 27.02.2024, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, which is taken on record as Mark 'X'.

(3) Perusal of the aforesaid order reveals that all three petitioners/accused have been discharged in FIR No.19 dated 28.01.2023, under



Section 13-A of the Gambling Act, 1867 and Section 7(3) of the Lottery Regulation Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana.

(4) In view of the above development, learned Counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition any further.

(5) Disposed off accordingly.

(6) Needless to say that in case the occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
