JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to pay him salary as electrician.
2. The petitioner is working with respondent as Casual Labour and he claims that he is getting salary of Casual Labour whereas he is working as electrician. He has sent representation dated 27.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) to respondents to consider his claim.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Shivoy Dhir, Senior Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-UOI.
5. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent-UOI submits that as per his instructions, the department has not received representation dated 27.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) accordingly, authorities could not act upon it.

7. The petitioner is claiming that he has sent aforesaid representation dated 27.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) whereas respondent is disputing its receipt. Be that as it may, the authorities are directed to consider the present petition alongwith its Annexures as representation of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order within 8 weeks from today.
