1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.183 dated 19.08.2022, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 21(c) of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing.
2. As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended and was found to be in possession of 280 gms of heroin.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has undergone about 01 year and 09 months and has clean antecedents. Out of 14 witnesses, none has been examined till date.
4. State counsel does not dispute that aforesaid factual assertions made by counsel for the petitioner.

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5. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. However, in addition to conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, the petitioner shall remain bound by the following conditions :-

- (i) The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.
- (ii) The petitioner shall not tamper with any evidence oral or documentary during the trial.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not absent himself on any date before the trial.
- (iv) The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.
- (v) The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any with the trial Court.
- (vi) The petitioner shall give his cellphone number to the police authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number without permission of the trial Court.
- (vii) The petitioner shall not in any manner try to delay the trial.

6. In case of breach of any of the aforesaid conditions and those which may be imposed by the Trial Court, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

7. Ordered accordingly.
