1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to regularize him against a vacant post.
2. The petitioner, on 24.12.2016, joined Punjab Police as Cook on daily wage basis. He is working with respondent since then. The grievance of the petitioner is that his juniors have been regularized, however, despite vacancy of 7 seats, he has not been regularized.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that petitioner has filed representation dated 06.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) before the competent authority which is still pending. He

assures the Court that competent authority would look into the matter and decide claim of the petitioner within three months from today.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
