1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to the respondents to regularize them against vacant posts.
2. The petitioners, on 19.01.2019, joined Punjab Police as Cook on daily wage basis. They are working with respondent since then. The grievance of the petitioners is that their juniors have been regularized, however, despite vacancy of 7 seats, they have not been regularized.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that petitioners have filed representation dated 06.01.2024

assures the Court that competent authority would look into the matter and decide claim of the petitioners within three months from today.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
