1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 14.11.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-10189-2023.

2. In response, compliance report by way of affidavit of Mr. Rahul Jain, General Manger, Haryana Roadway, Jind, has been filed on behalf of respondents in Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the case of the petitioner has been considered and he, on instructions, submits that the actual financial benefits shall be released to the petitioner within a period of three weeks from today.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
5. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
6. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
