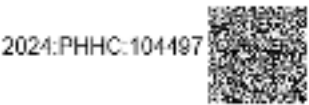

1. The applicant-petitioner has filed the present application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to place on record the photostat copy of the alert message dated 30.03.2024 (Annexure P-12) sent by Bank of India to the petitioner and the Bank statement (Annexure P-13) and also exemption from filing the certified / fair typed copy of Annexures P-12 and P-13.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the exemption sought is exempted. Annexures P-12 and P-13 are taken on record.

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.37 dated



02.02.2023, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Sector-14, Panchkula.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.03.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 04.03.2024, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
