Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners were given current duty charge of the post of Sub Divisional Officer, which was withdrawn whereas, respondent No.3, who was junior to the petitioner was allowed to retain the said charge, which action of the respondents was arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.3 submits that respondent No.3 has already retired from service hence, seniority between the petitioners and respondent No.3 has no consequence as of now.

Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that



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during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioners have already been granted regular post of Sub Divisional Officer. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as respondent No.3 has already retired from service, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to revive the present petition in case, petitioners still intend to pursue the present remedy.
