SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have approached this Court for directing the learned District Judge, Ludhiana to decide the application filed by the petitioners under Section 36 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act (for short 'the Act'), as well as objections preferred under Section 34 of the Act in a time bound manner.
2. At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that as the application under Section 36(2) of the Act is pending, he confines his prayer to issuance of a direction to the court concerned to dispose it of expeditiously.
3. Prayer made has been considered.

4. Learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana shall make an endeavour and shall decide the application under Section 36(2) of the Act as expeditiously as possible.
5. Petition is disposed of.
6. This order has been passed without examining and expressing any opinion on the merits of the application and the objections filed by the petitioners.
