1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari/prohibition/mandamus for quashing the order dated 31.12.1999 (Annexure P-6) to the extent it gives promotion to the petitioner to the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector on adhoc basis w.e.f. 21.12.1999.

2. Learned State counsel as submitted that the petitioner has already retired on 30.04.2013 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inspite of the best efforts, he has not been able to get in touch with the petitioner

and hence, he prays that the present petition may be disposed of at this stage but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause of action survives.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
