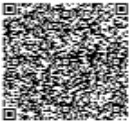

MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.187 dated 07.10.2023 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. On 04.03.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked her to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case in hand for allegedly procuring a Government job on the basis of a fake certificate. It has been submitted that similarly situated co-accused have since been extended the concession of interim bail by this Court vide order dated



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05.02.2024 (Annexure P-4).”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 04.03.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for her custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.03.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
