1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for wilful and deliberately disobeying the order dated 31.07.2023, passed by this Court in CWP - 6 of 2021 titled as 'Gurbhag Singh vs State of Punjab and others'.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order qua which the contempt petition is asserted; has been complied with by passing a speaking order dated 23.05.2024 and copy whereof has been produced in Court today itself, which is taken on record.
3. The Registry is directed to scan copy of the speaking order dated 23.05.2024 and place the same on the file, at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any the grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
