1. The dispute in the present case is with respect to recovery of Rs.28,375/- . While admitting the appeal on 22.09.1994, the following order was passed:-

“Admitted.

During the pendency of the appeal, appellant shall be entitled to deduct a sum of Rs.150/- per month from the account of the respondent.”

2. The learned counsel representing the appellant very fairly submits that the appeal is rendered infructuous and be disposed of as such as due to the order passed by the court on 22.09.1994, the entire amount must have been recovered.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
