Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the award dated 20.03.1996 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter is of the year 2001 and in spite of his best efforts, she has not been able to get in touch with her client and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage but liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
