ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. The learned counsel representing the respondent submits that the vacant piece of land was rented out to Haryana State Minor Irrigation and Tubewell Corporation for a period of one year with effect from 01.07.1972 to 30.06.1973, on a monthly rent of Rs.500/- for stocking their pipes.

2. The plaintiff filed a suit for mandatory injunction directing the defendants to vacate the strip of land measuring 60x215 feet abutting the plaintiff's cold storage. The learned counsel representing the respondent submits that the Haryana State Minor Irrigation and Tubewell Corporation was wound up and pursuant to a settlement arrived at between the parties, the possession of the entire property has been delivered back to the defendants. Hence, the regular second appeal has been rendered infructuous.

3. The learned counsel representing the appellants-Corporation submits that he has no information about the aforesaid development and he

cannot make any statement.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the regular second appeal is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the appellants to file an application for revival, if the facts are otherwise.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
