1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the impugned order dated 12.08.2004 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner has been compulsorily retired from service.

2. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment to get instructions from the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same, in case any cause of action still survives.
