HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that they have not been considered eligible as certain documents which the petitioners, though have uploaded but were not available with respondent No.2. Hence the respondents are under obligation to grant the petitioners another opportunity to upload those documents so as to consider them eligible for the post in question.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned State counsel submits that with regard to the non uploading of the certain documents due to technical glitch which has already been resolved by the Commission by issuance of letter dated

10.02.2024 and another chance had already been given to the petitioners and other similarly situated candidates to upload their documents in case they had valid documents to support their claim, issued to them prior to the last date of hearing.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition has already been raised through a representation dated 08.02.2024 (Annexure P-9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation of the petitioners dated 08.02.2024 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the concerned authorities within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
