The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.690 dated 03.11.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 302, 323 of the IPC, 1860 (subsequently added Section 201 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Vishnu Prasad, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, NIT Faridabad along with custody certificate has been filed on behalf of respondent- State.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused Robin @ Ravi has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 15.01.2024 passed in CRM-M-40505-2023 (Annexure P-2). Learned counsel contends further that case of the petitioner is on better footing.

4. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contention to the effect that case of the petitioner is at least on parity with co-accused Robin @ Ravi, who has already been allowed bail. The custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel would reveal that petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 01 month and 06 days, with no criminal antecedents.

5. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, and on the basis of parity and also for all the reasons as have been given by this Court in order dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed in CRM-M-40505-2023 *qua* co-accused Robin @ Ravi, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
