VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No. 2 to entertain the application of the petitioner for the grant of Contract Carriage Permits and a writ in the nature of certiorari declaring that respondent No. 2 is not competent to limit the number of contract carriages and other prayers have also been made in the writ petition.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not in touch with the petitioner and the present matter pertains to the year 1997 and in all likelihood, nothing survives in the matter and thus, the present petition in all probability has been rendered infructuous. He

further prays that liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present petition, in case any cause survives.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the same in case any cause survives.
