RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 03.07.2023 passed in CWP-13080-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Gottimukkala Vijay Kumar, Under Secretary to Govt. of India, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order 03.07.2023 passed in CWP-13080-2023 has since been complied with and necessary payment has been released in favour of the petitioner. Copy of bank entry to that effect has also been produced before the Court.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
