1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order Annexure P-8 passed by respondent No.2.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is of the year 2000 and there is no stay and thus, in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect inspite of the report of the registry that the counsel for the petitioner has been informed.
