1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he had participated for the post of Dental Hygienist in pursuance to the advertisement No. 3/2023 but, the petitioner has not been selected even though, 09 posts are still lying vacant in the general category in which the petitioner was competing.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once advertised post are lying vacant and the petitioner is available to be considered against the said vacant post, non filing of the said posts by not considering the claim of the petitioner, is causing prejudice to him
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition has already been raised by the petitioner through a representation dated 16.02.2024 (Annexure P-18) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time

bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation of the petitioner dated 16.02.2024 (Annexure P-18) has been received in the office and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the concerned authorities within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision, it is found feasible to extend any relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned while passing the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
8. Ordered accordingly.
