1. The present petition has been filed for seeking setting aside the impugned order dated 29.1.2024 (Annexure P-3), passed by the learned trial Court concerned in FIR No.233 dated 11.9.2021, under Sections 21/21C/27(a)/29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to point out any illegality in the order(supra), wherethrough, bail bond of the present petitioner has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him. However, he submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court concerned. He further submits that only because of his non-appearance on one day, the impugned order(supra) has been passed.
3. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court within 15 days from today. In case the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court concerned, within the prescribed time period and moves an application for regular bail, the same shall be heard and decided on the same day. Till then the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.
4. **Disposed of** accordingly.
