1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.221 dated 19.09.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.
2. Vide order dated 09.03.2023, the petitioner was granted interim protection and vide order dated 20.01.2024, he was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 20.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has

joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

4. In view of the above, interim orders dated 09.03.2023 and 20.01.2024 are made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. The present petition stands disposed off.
