The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.184 dated 02.11.2023 registered under Sections 323, 324, 295, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at P.S. Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.03.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 11.03.2024 of Mr. Jasbinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-A, Ludhiana in the Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions from submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 04.03.2024 and is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 04.03.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
